ASA SCHOLARSHIP

These scholarships are open to all fields of study. The student's career choice does not have to be construction related. Students may use the scholarship for **any** post-secondary school. Post-secondary education is not limited to colleges; ***scholarships may used for trade or vocational schools.***

GUIDELINES FOR ELIGIBILITY FOR ALL SCHOLARSHIPS:

1. The scholarships are to be used for one or more of the following: Pursuit of a 4-year college degree; 2-year college degree; trade, technical or vocational school certificates or degrees; **or** continuing education at a college, trade, technical or vocational school.
2. Scholarships are open to companies that are members of ASA of Sacramento. Applicant must be a family member of an employee of a member company or an employee of a member company.
3. A member of ASA of Sacramento must nominate the applicant and sign application form.
4. Applicants can be high school seniors, graduating in the class of 2026 or currently enrolled students in a four-year college, community college, apprenticeship, trade, technical or vocational educational program.
5. The committee may require an interview.
6. Completed applications must be e-mailed or postmarked on or before **October 22, 2025**.
